Many thanks also go to our friends from Haxey Church, whose generous donation of £300 brought the grand total for the charity to £1325.

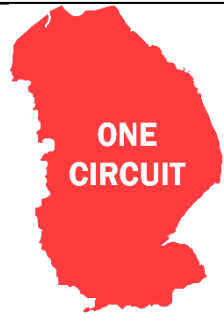
