# THEME: SHARING YOUR CLOAK - MISSION OUTSIDE OF THE CHURCH



Having been an historian and teacher by trade, I was surprised and puzzled to receive what looked very like the return of a clear call to the ministry of a chaplain that I had first felt some twenty years earlier whilst engaged in theological education. I have been a chaplain with MHA for ten years, working amongst the very old, often overlooked by society and the church, and alongside younger staff and relatives few of whom would ever dream of darkening the doorstep of a church. I do a number of things within MHA but am based mainly at starr hills in lytham, a 36 room residential home, and hatherlow house in Southport: 34 apartments with care on site serving those who are and are not living with dementia. End of life care and funeral ministry are a large part of my role but I also spend much time helping to build a positive, outward looking, genuine community of people in both places with a strong sense of purpose, belonging and a vibrant tradition of worship at the centre.
